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Executive Summary

The 11th Kolkata Medical Mission was the second Medical Mission in this city in 2015. The mission was organized from 23rd - 28th November, 2015 at Flemming Hospital, Kolkata.

There were a total no. of 151 patients who came on the day of the screening. Out of 151 patients 100 patients had been provided with this life changing transformational surgery. The majority of patients in the mission were from North and South 24 Parganas, Medinipur, Howrah and Hooghly districts of the state.

Over 30 Medical volunteers travelled across the country to be a part of the mission. Their dedication and love for this cause made this surgical procedure and transformation process safe and successful. The team consists of Surgeons, Anesthetists, Pediatrician, Child Life Counselor and the team of Nurses.

To perform a medical mission smoothly the role played by the non-medical volunteers is very important, we had a huge participation of non-medical volunteers from various corporates and also from our social media sites and schools who volunteered in this mission.

We are very grateful to Kevin Spencer, Raja Balasuriya and Gunther Saacke for sponsoring the 100 surgeries in the mission and thankful to Sunil Talwar & Raj Khosla for championing the cause.

Sandeep Paramanik (1 Year)

Sandeep is the only child of Ekadoshi and Prasanta. His mother, Ekadoshi was very happy when she came to know that she was pregnant. The whole family rejoiced waiting for their child. But, their joy was short lived when they found that their child is born with cleft lip and cleft palate.

Her in-laws and her husband were not aware of this deformity and they blamed her for giving birth to this baby. It was only when Mission Smile organised a pre-screening camp in a near-by village Ghatakpukur, the parents came to know that the deformity of their son Sandeep can be corrected through a simple surgery.

Prasanta made the arrangements & brought Ekadoshi and Sandeep to the mission site on 22nd Nov, 2015. They were surprised to see so many children like their son born with this painful condition. Finally, after the rounds of screening and medical evaluations, Sandeep was found fit for surgery.

Ekadoshi was very nervous when the nurse wheeled in Sandeep for his surgery. The nervous wait was over when they brought Sandeep out of the O.T. Both Ekadoshi and Prasanta were very happy and showed their gratitude to the donors and supporters without whom the transformation of their child would not have been possible.

They also thanked Mission Smile for providing such a life changing surgery and comprehensive care to their child. They also said that after reaching home they will share about Mission Smile and referring cleft children for a free surgery in their locality by sending a simple sms.

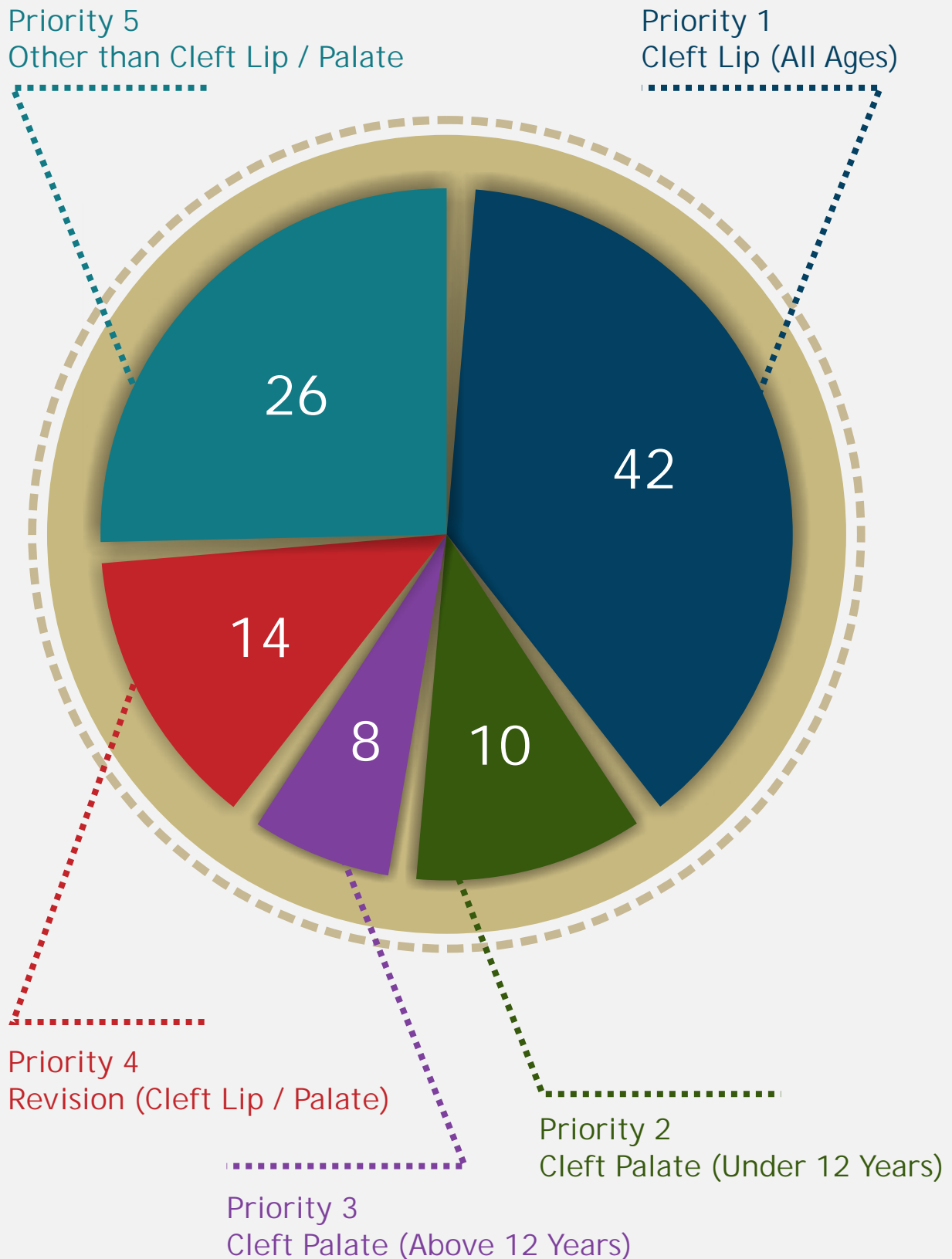

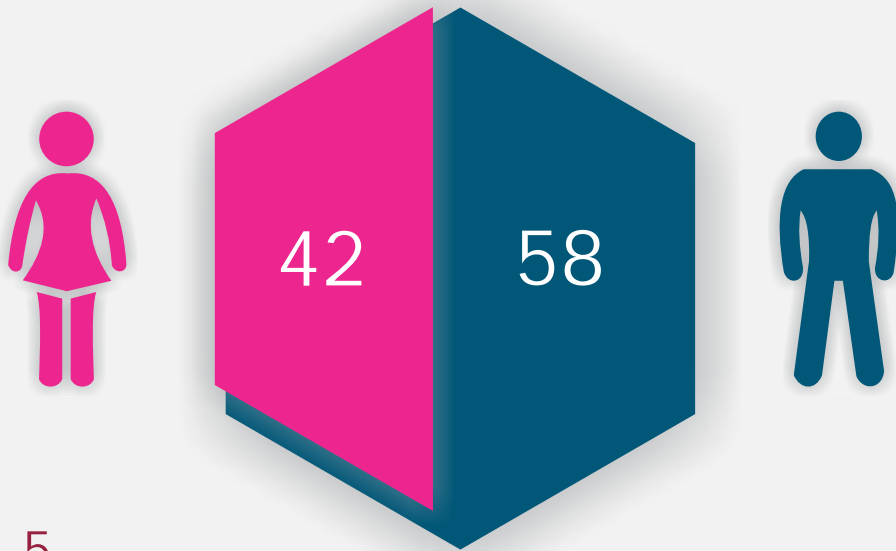
Graphical Representation-I

Segregation of Patients as per Priority Level



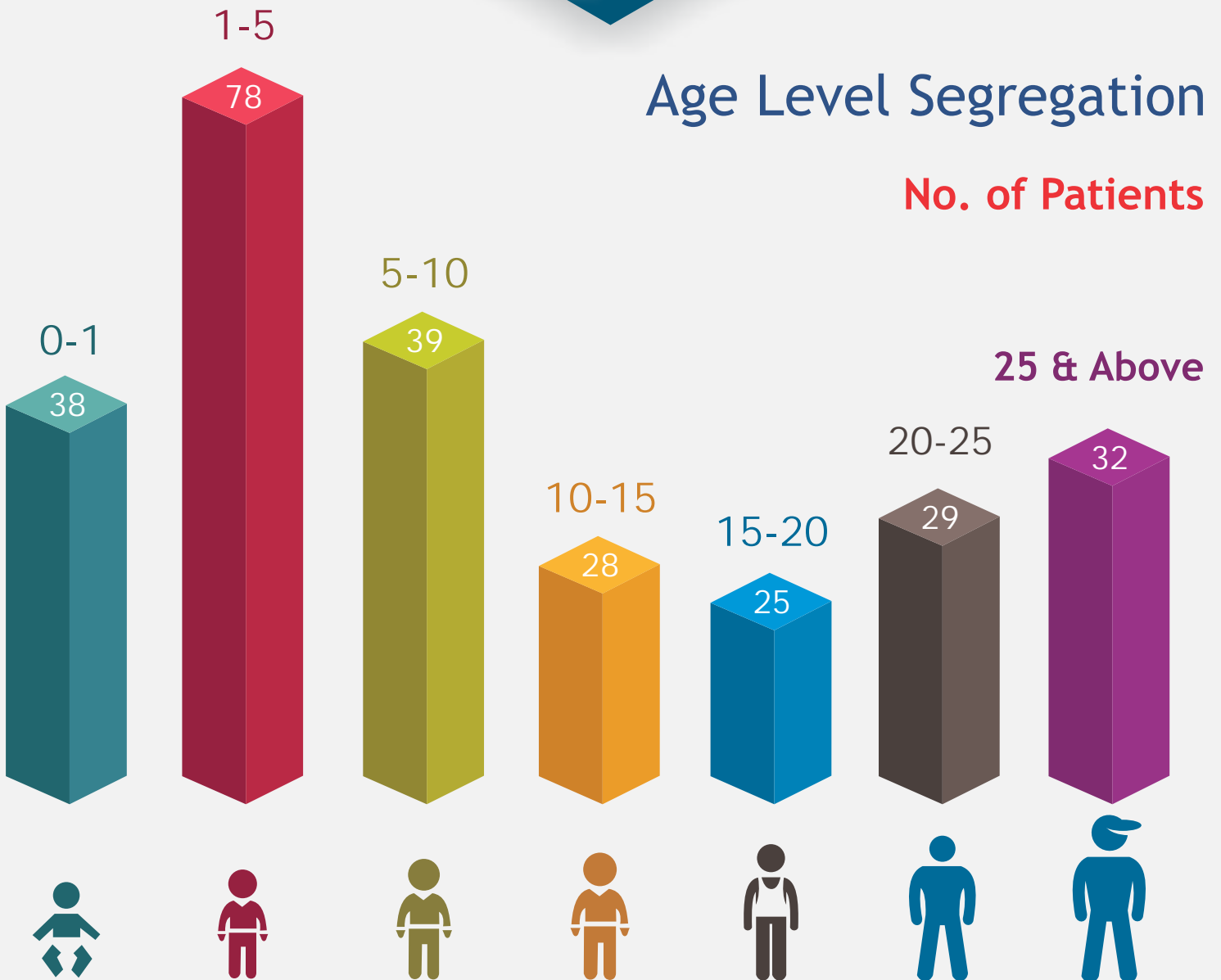
Graphical Representation-II

Smile Story-I

Bittu Das was born to Saraswati and Biswanath in a village near Bally chak, a small town in West Bengal. Their family never had a cleft birth in their family and village. They thought that due to the curse of God, their child was born with this deformity. Hence immediately after Bittu was born they organised a mass-prayer at their home to purify themselves and their family from this curse.

Later they heard from a nearby youth association, named Netaji Sangha about the mission. This club was organising a screening camp for the mission and Bittu was selected for the mission.

On 21st November, the family started their journey to reach the mission site. The family attended the screening camp on 22nd November at Flemming Hospital, Kolkata. The family travelled for a long distance and attended the screening camp. As the Bittu was being screened through the different stations, Saraswati, Bittu's mother, in heart prayed for her child to get selected. In the evening she was glad to hear that her child has been selected.

The surgery was conducted on 26th November, next day morning when Saraswati saw Bittu, she was very happy. His lips were now joined. Saraswati exclaimed that her son is now looking more beautiful and normal like any other child in their village. She was joined by her husband, Biswanath who thanked profusely to the team who took care of everything - right from travel, to food and boarding and finally their child's surgery.

Biswanath confessed that without support even bringing their child for surgery with his meager income would have been difficult. He thanked that this surgery was God's gift to his family.

Smile Story-II

Sahirul Ali was the 2nd child of Sahidul Sahui (Father) and Mumtaz Bibi (Mother). Unlike his other brothers, he was born with Cleft Lip. Though they had few other children in the village born with this deformity, having their own child with this deformity was totally different.

Although, when Sahirul was born, the doctor explained them the problem and explained that this deformity can be cured, their modest income prevented them from looking at measures to correct their child's deformity. Sahidul works as a farmer in his village and Mumtaz Bibi is a housewife. Hence, Sahirul had to wait for more than 9 years to get back his Smile.



During our Pre-mission campaign in their village, his family was able to know about this mission which would correct deformity of 100 children. He, along with his family visited the pre-screening camp, where he was selected to attend the screening camp at the mission site.

Sahirul's along with his family visited the mission site and he was selected for the surgery procedure. His surgery was performed under utmost care. The family was surprised to see the change in their son's face. The broken lip is changed into a beautiful smile. The family thanked Mission
